Nearly a quarter of a million children living in the United States have blood lead levels high enough to cause significant damage to their health, estimates the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), based on data from a 2003–2004 national

survey. Major sources of lead exposure among U.S. children are lead-based paint and lead-contaminated dust found in deteriorating buildings.

To increase awareness of childhood lead poisoning prevention, Bridgeport Neighborhood Trust is participating in National Lead Poisoning Prevention Week (NLPPW) October 23–29th with the **Healthy Homes Fair**.

In observance of NLPPW, there will be free lead screenings, partnered with education from vendors around the state.
